



# TMIP CHCS - Caché (TC<sup>2</sup>)

## DEPLOYED INPATIENT DOCUMENTATION SOLUTION

**The Theater Medical Information Program - Joint Composite Health Care System - Caché (TC<sup>2</sup>) allows military health care providers to access and document inpatient health care, order ancillary services and view results in the deployed environment.**

TC<sup>2</sup> provides documentation for inpatient health care and computer-based provider order-entry including ancillary services order-entry and result-reporting in the deployed environment. This delivers an effective, interoperable health care system to support the deployed medical business practice. Once documented, data is viewable in the electronic health record through the Theater Medical Data Store (TMDS). ## Key Features

- ▶ Captures Admission, Discharge and Transfer (ADT) encounter data
- ▶ Captures clinical notes to include Discharge Summaries
- ▶ Processes clinical orders and results for laboratory, radiology and pharmacy transactions
- ▶ Transmits real-time inpatient encounters, clinical notes, discharge summaries and ancillary results to TMDS as part of the life-time medical record
- ▶ Interfaces with laboratory instruments, radiology software and remote laboratories

## Key Benefits

- ▶ The Legacy application supports ancillary order processing and ADT transactions while the new Provider Order Entry Graphical User Interface (POE GUI) supports clinical order entry, clinical documentation and ancillary result reporting using a web-based front end which exposes the Legacy application capabilities in a modernized format.
- ▶ Continuing development efforts for the POE GUI will bring more capabilities to clinical and patient administration users. Clinical users will be able to enter Discharge Summaries, copy orders for inter-ward transfers, perform spell-check on notes; enter vital signs and fluid Intake/Output using a flow sheet and document medication administration using a flow sheet. Patient Administration users will be able to enter/edit patient registrations, process ADT transactions and produce reports using the GUI.
