A second component, Dolphin Imaging, is a digital orthodontic management application and digital secondary file of both the legacy and electronic dental health records used in 23 Air Force active duty clinics. Personal Information is collected from the following groups of individuals: AF Active Duty and their dependents, AFRC, ANG, and other eligible beneficiaries. Patient images collected in a patient record in MiPACS are tagged with the patient's name, primary identifier (DOD ID and/or SSN), date of birth, and gender.
