


Tidewater Military Health System (TMHS)



- We have recently executed a lease for the Williamsburg Community Based Medical Home (CBMH)
- Planning for buildout began 3rd week of October 2017
- Projected opening: Summer 2018
- Projected Enrollment approximately 6,400





Healthcare Delivery

MCAHC FY17 closeout:

- Specialty Care closed out at 110.8%
- Primary Care closed out at 91.4%
- MCAHC rolling 12 month Perspective Payment System (PPS) Value was \$27,759,297 or 100.8% of projection
- Surgical Services Surgical Lines closed out with 87,746 Ambulatory Payment Classification (APC) achieved or approximately 99% of FY17APC target
- Enrollment: FY17 MCAHC Command Team projection was 24,712. MCAHC reached 97% of Performance Plan target
- Access to Care: Rolling 13 review MCAHC maintain access standards for Acute (24HR) and Future (FTR) appointments
- CPAC/HR Time to Hire Partnership: Time to hire decreased from 260 days to 85 days since February 2017
- Coding: Coders are performing 100% touch of all encounters. Thru the month of July facility met or exceeded standards in all areas of Coding, E&M, ICD, CPT


Ophthalmology Clinic

Removal (offer pterygium removal with conjunctiva! autograft), Eyelid Excisional Biopsies, Chalazion Incision and Curettage, Laser treatment for retinal tears, diabetic retinopathy, glaucoma(SLT) etc. (Laser Refraction Surgery for Active Dutypatients).


