Biographical Note: Dr. Morris Steggerda was born in Holland, Michigan, in 1900, to John and Sena Steggerda. He obtained his A.B. at Hope College in 1922, his A.M. and Ph.D. from the University of Illinois in 1923 and 1928 respectively, in the Department of Zoology. In 1928, he married Inez Dunkelberger, an instructor at Smith College, and in 1932 their son Charles Steggerda was born. Dr. Steggerda began his career as Assistant Professor of Zoology at Smith College before becoming an Investigator with the Carnegie Institution of Washington at Cold Spring Harbor from 1930 to 1944. Thereafter, he was Professor of Anthropology at the Hartford Seminary Foundation.

Early in his career, Steggerda's background in genetics and psychology attracted the attention of Charles Davenport, the prominent American eugenicist and biologist. From 1926 to 1928 they collaborated on a study of the British West Indies that formed the basis of Steggerda's doctoral dissertation (on the 'Negro-White hybridizations' he documented). Steggerda and Davenport subsequently collaborated on a series of publications, including most notably *Race-Crossing in Jamaica*. As an Investigator with the Carnegie Institution, Steggerda conducted studies that took him on two trips to Europe, ten to the Yucatan, numerous visits to the Tuskegee Institute, to the Navajo Reservation, and back to Holland, Michigan, where he traced the history of his own ethnic kin. Research from each of these trips is documented in this collection.

Series/Scope and Content Note: The predominantly anthropometric records in this collection were created and compiled by Steggerda throughout his illustrious career as a physical anthropologist. The collection includes a wide range of data gathered on a series of research projects, in a number of different formats, including photographs, anthropometric measurements, hair samples, palm prints, and dental records of American Indians, Jamaicans, Tuskegee University students, Mayans, Dutch school children, and white and black Americans. SERIES 001: JAMAICA STUDIES

The sixteen boxes in this series include a wide range of tests conducted with Jamaican youth, at a variety of schools, from kindergartens to colleges. The following are included: music tests, drawing tests, form substitution and discrimination tests, Army Beta and Alpha tests, and the Downey Group Will-Temperament test. Additional materials include photographs, teeth charts, autobiographies, hair samples, anthropometric measurements, family histories, family trees, and correspondence items. The parenthetical numbers in the box list in this and other series denote the range of page numbers covering the subject, as labeled on the documents contained therein. Pages missing from this series are listed in Box 016, Folder 00008. An index for the page numbers listed in parentheses is also provided in Box 001, Folder 00001.

SERIES 002: AMERICAN INDIAN STUDIES

Boxes 017-023 include anthropometric measurements, photographs, tooth charts, and initial hand/foot outlines, mostly of children, with some measurements taken for up to 10 years. Box 024 through Box 028 include lists of names involved in studies, graphs, tables, photographs, pedigrees, computational charts, and additional test results and study results. The bulk of material is related to Navajos, but additional material for Hopi, Zuni, and other New Mexican tribes is also represented. Additional material on the subject of American Indians can be found in the following: Boxes 063-072, 075-75, and Box 080.

SERIES 003: TUSKEGEE DATA

Box 029 and Box 030 include data from the study of Tuskegee children, including anthropometric measurements, photographs, tooth charts, and initial hand/foot outlines, mostly longitudinally measured. Additional material in Box 031 and Box 032 includes checking sheets, study reports, calculations, pedigrees, lists, and photographs. Additional material on the subject of Tuskegee can be found in Boxes 065, 070, 071 and 074.

SERIES 004: HOLLAND SCHOOL SERIES

Boxes 033-035 include test data for Dutch school children from anthropometric measurements, tooth charts, and initial hand/foot outlines, longitudinally measured (up to 10 years). Box 036 through Box 039 includes ancestry letters with biographical narratives, additional study results, data, lists, charts and calculations. Additional material on Hollanders can be found in Boxes 066, 074 and 079.



SERIES 005: MAYAN SERIES

Boxes 040-042 and Box 46-51 contain data from studies, including anthropometric measurements, tooth charts, photographs, palm and foot prints, and initial hand/foot outlines, with some longitudinal data up to 10 years. Additional items include research notes, reports, lists, checking sheets, standards, census data and pedigrees. Photographs, arranged by subject, can be found in Boxes 043-045 and 052-053. Additional Mayan materials can be found in Boxes 062-064, 066-067, 071, 073, 075, 076, and 080.

SERIES 006: SOUTH AMERICAN SERIES

Boxes 054-058 contain descriptive, anthropometric, and ethnological data for South American Indian Groups. The folders are arranged alphabetically to include tribe names, countries and regions. Most folders include a summary data sheet that describes linguistic stock, habitat, ethnological data, physical characteristics, and location. Also includes handwritten notes, notecards, citations, précis, some secondary literature, anthropometry, and correspondence. South American studies are also addressed in Box 070.

SERIES 007: FAMILY HISTORY SERIES

Boxes 059-061 include family history studies begun by Steggerda at the University of Illinois. Materials collected on Steggerda's family include palm prints, anthropometry sheets, pedigrees, measurement data, biographical notes, computational sheets and photographs.

SERIES 008: MISCELLANEOUS AND SUPPLEMENTAL MATERIAL

This series includes material that supplements each of the other series as well as some additional, original material from studies of other groups including children at Cold Springs Harbor and several New York schools. Materials include correspondence, calculations, lists, maps, and photographs. Boxes 077-078 include a number of Steggerda's personal papers, including reprints, copies, and notes.

SERIES 009: CASES—SLIDES AND LISTS

Case 001-002 primarily include slides (negatives and positives) of the Dutch, African Americans, Yucatan, Navajo, and Mayan people. Glass plates of Mexicans, North Americans, South Americans, Asians, and Mayans can also be found in these cases. Cases 003-004 include alphabetical lists of Navajo Indian names, Hollanders, and Jamaicans. Additional miscellaneous negatives and lists of publications can also be found in Case 004.
